

# **APS Intellectual Property Rights Policies**

The American Phytopathological Society - 3 September 1999

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In 1999, the ad hoc Intellectual Property Rights Committee (IPRC) was charged to advise APS and its relevant publication boards regarding appropriate policies for copyright and for use of the society's copyrighted holdings. The committee was to take into account the societal goals and objectives defined in the society's strategic plan, namely, to "become the premiere resource for plant health information and knowledge dissemination (and) the foremost internet resource for all aspects of plant health." In addition, the policies were to assure reasonable access to and use of materials by both their original contributors and the society's members and clientele while protecting or enhancing APS's financial health. Intellectual property rights policies will be monitored and modified periodically by the APS Publications Board as appropriate.

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
